

HOW TO SEW A SEATBELT COVER

Supplies:

- Fabric (Any kind of fabric. It doesn't need to be fleece)
- Batting
- Velcro

1. Cut two pieces of fabric into 7x9 inch rectangles.
2. Cut two pieces of batting into 7x9 inch rectangles.
3. Lay one piece of batting down on the table. Place a piece of fabric right side up. Next, place a piece of fabric right side down. Place a piece of batting on top. Secure with a few pins.
4. Sew the fabric along 3 sides. You can sew part of the 4th side, but leave an opening to turn the fabric.
5. Turn the fabric right side out. Hand-stitch the opening closed.
6. Cut two pieces of Velcro to be 8-1/2 inches long.
7. Position one of the pieces of Velcro along the longest side on the left side of the fabric, and sew into place.
8. Sew the matching Velcro strip on the opposite side and end, and sew into place. Make sure the two sides can be attached together when folded over the seat belt.
