How can we help you minister to the breast cancer patients and survivors who may be a part of your church family? A cancer journey is such a difficult road to walk, and we would like to come alongside you as you support them.

We are a local, small nonprofit organization that I founded because I am a breast cancer survivor and God called me to minister to other women who are walking the same road that I have walked. We provide care packages and mastectomy pillows free to anyone going through breast cancer treatment. We do ask them for a little help with any shipping costs, but we hope to soon be able to cover shipping costs. We offer hope and encouragement to let her know she is not alone on her journey. We will support her at any point in her breast cancer journey.

We work with patient navigators at several cancer centers. We provide care packages to the cancer center in Williamsport so that all new breast cancer patients in our communities receive one of our care packages. We have mailed care packages to women in 48 states, and even to Canada.

After years of operating out of my home, we recently moved to the heart of downtown Lock Haven. God has provided us a place to be able to meet the needs of our local breast cancer warriors in more tangible ways! We are excited that we will soon have support group meetings and Bible studies that are geared towards being a breast cancer patient. We are working to collect local resources to be able to minister to the ladies. We are so proud of our amazing community for collaborating with us on some exciting things that we will be offering soon.

This information packet shows the various ways that you can partner with us to help minister to the breast cancer patients and survivors in our community, and beyond. There are a lot of opportunities to volunteer with us as well.
